

Pioneer Road Complete Streets

Refined Concepts

Draft

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The goal of the Pioneer Road Complete Streets project is to explore the potential for making Pioneer Road an attractive boulevard and providing a new east-west connection for cars and trucks that would include safe, comfortable facilities for people walking and bicycling. It is funded by a grant from the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans). The project's study area is Pioneer Road from Volta Road to the west to Ward Road to the east, along with several potential north-south connections from Pacheco Boulevard to Pioneer Road.

This Refined Concepts packet presents a set of improvements for Pioneer Road as well as a proposed alignment for connections from Pioneer Road to Pacheco Boulevard. The proposed improvements and alignment are the result of an extensive outreach process that included two community workshops, several stakeholder meetings, and an online survey. The outcome of this community outreach helped the project team create the concepts that are presented in this packet. The concept consists of two alignments: an interim alignment to be developed initially, which includes a new road east of Los Banos Creek and a widening of Ward Road; and a longterm alignment extending Pioneer Road westward to Volta Road, which would be developed in the future. The concept also includes a roadway section for Pioneer Road which includes four lanes of traffic, a landscaped median, and a shared bicycle/pedestrian path along the north side. The width of Pioneer Road is reduced by eliminating the median where required to avoid impacting existing properties and structures.


Project Overview Map





East of Creek Alignment Diagram

This diagram shows the East of Creek Alignment that would connect Pacheco Boulevard with Pioneer Road. The alignment would be connected to future development to the east. This diagram is based on plans for an approved planned development.






Pioneer Rd (Looking East) and Ward Road (Looking North)

For Pioneer Road and Ward Road, the concept has four lanes of traffic, a landscaped median, and a shared bicycle/pedestrian path along the north side of Pioneer Road and west side of Ward Road. The opposite sides of the street would be enhanced with landscaping and a sidewalk if the land is developed in the future. The roadway width is reduced by eliminating the median where required to avoid impacting existing properties and structures.

East of Creek Alignment (Looking North)

For the East of Creek alignment, there are four lanes of traffic, a landscaped median, and a shared bicycle/pedestrian path along the west side. Like Pioneer and Ward Road, the other side of the street would be enhanced with landscaping and a sidewalk in the future.

Example Location 1: Pioneer Road at Ortigalita Road



Ortigalita Road provides a key north-south route between Pioneer Road and Pacheco Boulevard. This concept view (looking east) shows a signalized intersection with left-turn lanes on Pioneer Road in both directions and a right-turn lane in the westbound direction. Ortigalita Road is also shown developed to four travel lanes to the north of Pioneer Road.

There is a bicycle/pedestrian path on the north side. The south side of the street would be enhanced with landscaping and a sidewalk if the

residential uses, and there are existing structures on the south side (just out of view). To avoid impacts to existing structures the center median is reduced to narrow the road width. The roadway returns back to normal width in the distance. There is a bicycle/pedestrian path on the north side. The south side of the street would be enhanced with landscaping and a sidewalk if the land is developed in the future. 
Example Location 3: Pioneer Road east of Mercey Springs Road



East of Mercey Springs Road, Pioneer Road would have two travel lanes in each direction and a 16'-wide landscaped median.

There is a bicycle/pedestrian path on the north side. The south side of the street would be enhanced if the land is developed in the future.









Concept Segments Key Map


Concept Alignment: East of Creek Connection






Concept Alignment: East of Creek Connection






Concept Alignment: East of Creek Connection and Pioneer Road




























Concept Alignment: Pioneer Road and Ward Road








